

**CITY OF SIOUX FALLS GOLF COURSES  
2019 SEASON PASS INFORMATION**

**ADD SPOUSE and/or CHILDREN to ANY PASS**

When added to an Alltime pass, children under 19 have same restrictions as a Youth pass. When added to a Weekday pass, spouse and children are also limited to play only on weekdays.

**WEEKDAY PASSES**

Weekday passes exclude play on weekends and before noon on the following holidays: Monday, May 27, Thursday, July 4, and Monday, September 2.

**AGE DEFINITIONS FOR SENIOR, YOUNG ADULT AND JUNIOR PASSES**

Seniors must be 65 years of age before August 1, 2019.

Students must be under 23 years of age on April 1, 2019

Young Executive passholders must be under 41 years of age on April 1, 2019

Youth must be under 18 years of age on April 1, 2019 or 19 if a 2019 high school graduate.

Super Seniors must be at least 85 years of age before August 1, 2019.

**REGISTERING FOR PLAY**

**Passholders must present their pass card** whenever registering for play at any of the courses. Checking in with your card is fast and more accurate. You will not be allowed to play without your pass card. Transfer of your pass card to another golfer is not allowed and will result in forfeiture of playing privileges. You may occasionally be asked to provide a picture I.D. with your card when registering for play.

**COURSE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Passholders agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the golf courses, including but not limited to the following:

- Pace of play requirements.
- Registration procedures.
- Tee time procedures.
- Golf course etiquette, replacing divots, repairing ball marks, and raking traps.
- Golf car regulations.
- Responsible use of alcohol by adults.
- Food and beverages must be purchased at the golf course.

**ELMWOOD / KUEHN PARK / PRAIRIE GREEN  
2019 SEASON PASS REGULATIONS**

- \*\*\* You **MUST** present your pass card when registering for play at any of the golf courses. Checking in with your pass card is faster and more accurate!
- \*\*\* If you lose your card, report it immediately and a new card with a new pass number will be issued.
- \*\*\* Passholders are expected to follow all course rules and regulations, including pace of play requirements and tee time procedures.

\*\*\* **REFUND POLICY - SEASON PASSES**

**MAXIMUM REFUNDS AVAILABLE:**

BEFORE THE COURSE OPENS---	<b>100%</b>
OPENING DAY – 4/30/2019-----	<b>75%</b>
5/1/2019-5/31/2019-----	<b>50%</b>
6/1/2019-6/30/2019-----	<b>25%</b>

\*\*\* **no refunds after 6/30/2019** \*\*\*

\*\*\* **All refunds and exchanges pay a \$25 fee** \*\*\*

Your refund may be less based on how much you have used your pass. We will calculate your usage based on regular daily fees and subtract that amount from the price of your pass. If this amount is less than the appropriate amount in the table above, you will receive the smaller of the two amounts.

As an example, an Adult All-Time passholder at Elmwood applies for a refund on June 15<sup>th</sup> having played fifteen 18 hole rounds and twelve 9 hole rounds. We would compute the refund as follows:

<b>\$750.00 * 25% = \$187.50</b>	<b>or</b>	<b>15 rds * \$30.00 = \$ 450.00</b>
		<b>12 rds * \$18.50 = \$ 222.00</b>
		<b>TOTAL USED = \$ 672.00</b>
		<b>Price of Pass     \$ 750.00</b>
		<b>Unused part of pass = \$ 78.00</b>

This person would receive a \$78.00 refund. If the unused part of his pass was greater than \$187.50, he would receive the standard percentage refund of \$187.50. In all cases, an additional \$25 refund/exchange fee would be deducted from the amount.
